SHALL COME,

GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by Section 14 of The
Local School Tax (Amendment) Act, 1974,
the Act No. 60 of 1974, it is provided that the
said Act shall come into force on a day to
be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieuten-
ant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient
that the said Act shall come into force on
the tenth day of December, 1974;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with
the advice of Our Executive Council of Our
Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our
Proclamation declare and direct that the
said Act shall come into force on the tenth
day of December, 1974;

AND We do hereby further declare and
direct that Our Proclamation dated the
twenty-fifth day of November, 1974, be and
it is hereby rescinded;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUB-
JECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these
Presents may concern are hereby required
to take notice and to govern themselves
accordingly;

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have
caused these Our Letters to be made Patent
and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be
hereunto affixed.

WITNESS: Our trusty and well-
beloved the Honourable Gordon
Arnaud Winter, Officer of Our Order
of Canada, Lieutenant-Governor in
and for Our Province of Newfound-
land.

AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE in
Our City of St. John's this 4th. day
of December in the year of Our
Lord one thousand nine hundred
and seventy-four and in the twenty-
third year of Our Reign.
