WHEREAS in and by Section 48 of The Sol- emnization of Marriages Act, 1974, the Act No. 81 of 1974, it is provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclama- tion of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act shall come into force on Monday, the First day of November, 1976;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Pro- vince of Newfoundland, do by this Our Procla- mation declare and direct that the said Act shall come into force on Monday, the First day of November, 1976;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

In the matter of the expropriation of land at Kilbride in the Electoral District of Kilbride in the Province of Newfoundland.

TO:

All persons and corporations having or claim- ing any estate or interest in the land hereinafter described:

TAKE NOTICE that the said land has been expropriated by Notice of Expropriation dated the 30th day of July A.D., 1976 in accordance with the Expropriation Act, Chapter 121 of the Revised Statutes of Newfoundland, 1970. The said land being more particularly described in the Schedule hereto attached,

ALL THAT piece or parcel of land situate at Kilbride, Electoral District of Kilbride, Province of Newfoundland, bounded and abutted as fol- lows, that is to say: Beginning at the most south- easterly angle of the property of the R.C. Epis- copal Corporation and the northwesterly limit of the Canadian National Railway right of way said point being distant thirty (30') feet, more or less, measured at right angles northwesterly from the centre line of the said C.N.R. right of way; proceeding thence south sixty-three de- grees thirty minutes east two hundred twenty (220') feet, more or less, along the northwesterly limit of the C.N.R. right of way aforesaid; thence north twenty-eight degrees zero minutes west two hundred forty-eight (248') feet, more or less; thence north fifty degrees thirty minutes east one hundred seventy (170') feet, more or less; thence north sixty-two degrees thirty mi- nutes east eighty-six (86') feet, more or less; thence south twenty-one degrees fifteen mi- nutes east two hundred eighty-seven (287') feet, more or less, to the point of commencement containing in all one point four nine six (1.496) acres.

All bearings are referred to the Magnetic Meridian.
