GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by Section 5 (1) of The Memorial University (Amendment) Act, 1974, the Act No. 86 of 1974, it is provided that Section 2 of the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that Section 2 of the said Act shall come into force on Sunday, the First day of June, 1975;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that Section 2 of the said Act shall come into force on lay, the First day of June, 1975;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these

Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS: Our trusty and well-beloved the Honourable Gordon Arnaud Winter, Officer of Our Order of Canada, Lieutenant-Governor in and for Our Province of Newfoundland.

AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE in Our City of St. John's this 21st. day of July in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five and in the twenty-fourth year of Our Reign.
