A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by Section 7 of The Labour Relations (Amendment) Act, 1974, the Act No. 98 of 1974, it is provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act shall come into force on the first day of January, 1975;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the said Act shall come into force on the first day of January, 1975;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these

Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS: Our trusty and well-beloved the Honourable Gordon Arnaud Winter, Officer of Our Order of Canada, Lieutenant-Governor in and for Our Province of Newfoundland.

PUBLIC NOTICE

In the matter of the expropriation of land at Corner Brook in the Electoral District of Humber West in the Province of Newfoundland.

TO:

All persons and corporations having or claiming any estate or interest in the land hereinafter described:

TAKE NOTICE that the said land has been expropriated by Notice of Expropriation dated the 20th day of December, A.D., 1974, in accordance with the Expropriation Act, Chapter 121 of the Revised Statutes of Newfoundland, 1970. The said land being more particularly described in the Schedule here-to attached:

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT piece or parcel of land at Elizabeth Street, Corner Brook West, bounded and described as follows, that is to say: Starting at a point on the Eastern limit of Elizabeth Street said point being found by running from the Southwest corner of the concrete foundation under the dwelling of

Ira Gillam South Twenty Six degrees (26) Twenty Six minutes West (26) for a distance of One Hundred Sixty One feet (161'); running thence from the above described starting point and by land of Westley Bartlett East Two Hundred Fifty Eight and Nine Tenths feet (258.09); thence by lr of G. Buchan South Thirteen (13) deg Sixteen (16) Minutes West Fifty (50) feet; thence by land of Selby Tuff West Two Hundred Fifty Nine (259) feet, and thence by the aforesaid Eastern limit of Elizabeth Street North Thirteen (13) degrees Twenty Three (23) Minutes East Fifty (50.0) feet to the starting point. Containing in all Fifteen Thousand One Hundred (15,100) square feet more or less.

All persons are hereby required to take notice that any person who wishes to view a plan of the land the subject of this Notice may view the same at the offices of the Department of Public Works and Services, St. John's, Newfoundland and that any person who wishes to obtain a copy thereof may obtain it at the said offices upon the payment of .50¢ for such copy.

All persons and corporations who have any interest in or claim against the said land or who have been injuriously affected by the said expropriation are required submit to the Minister of Public Works and Services, Department of Public Works and Services, Confederation Building, St. John's, Newfoundland by a date not later than the 20th day of March, A.D., 1975 the following:

- (a) a claim for compensation,
- (b) particulars of his estate and interest in the land expropriated or injuriously affected, and of every charge, lien or other encumbrance to which the land is subject, and
- (c) title deeds, plans and any other documents in his possession or available to him relating to the title to the land.
