A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by Section 17 of The Gender Development Corporation Act, 1975, the Act No. 61 of 1975, it is provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Administrator in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act shall come into force on Saturday, the First day of May, 1976;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the said Act shall come into force on Saturday, the First day of May, 1976;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS
AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may

concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS: Our trusty and well-beloved the Honourable Robert Stafford Furlong, Member of Our Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Chief Justice and Administrator in and for Our Province of Newfoundland.

AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE in Our City of St. John's this 29th day of April in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-six and in the twenty-fifth year of Our Reign.
