GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by Section 37 of The
Mining and Mineral Rights Tax Act, 1975,
the Act No. 68 of 1975, it is provided that the
said Act, or any Part, provision or part of
such provision thereof, shall come into force
on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our
Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient
that the said Act, with the exception of Sub-
sections (1) and (3) of Section 11 thereof,
shall come into force on Wednesday, the
First day of January, 1975; and that the said
Subsections (1) and (3) of Section 11 shall
come into force on Friday, the Eighteenth
day of July, 1975;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the
advice of Our Executive Council of Our Pro-
vince of Newfoundland, do by this Our Pro-
clamation declare and direct that the said Act,
with the exception of Subsections (1) and
(3) of Section 11 thereof, shall come into
force on Wednesday, the First day of Janu-
ary, 1975, and that the said Subsections (1)
and (3) of Section 11 shall come into force on
Friday, the Eighteenth day of July, 1975;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
