A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by Section 64 of The District Court Act, 1976, the Act No. 69 of 1975-76, it is provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act shall come into force on Thursday, Fourth day of August, 1977;

NOW KNOW Ye that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Procla-

mation declare and direct that the said Act shall come into force on Thursday, the Fourth day of August, 1977;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS: Our trusty and well-beloved the Honourable Gordon Arnaud Winter, Officer of Our Order of Canada, Lieutenant-Governor in and for Our Province of Newfoundland.

AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE in Our City of St. John's this 8th day of August in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-seven and in the twenty-sixth year of Our Reign.
