TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME,

GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 34 of *The Consumer Reporting Agencies Act*, Chapter 18 of  
1977, it is provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by  
Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act shall come into force on  
Monday, the second day of June, 1980;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our  
Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the said  
Act shall come into force on Monday, the second day of June, 1980;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these  
Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accord-  
ingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent  
and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS: Our trusty and well-beloved the Honourable Gordon Arnauld  
Winter, Officer of Our Order of Canada, Lieutenant-Governor in  
and for Our Province of Newfoundland.

AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE in Our City of St. John's this 1st day of  
May in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty  
and in the twenty-ninth year of Our Reign.
