A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by Section 155 of The Labour Relations Act, 1977, Chapter 64 of The

Statutes of Newfoundland, 1977, it is provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act shall come into force on Tuesday, the Twenty-first day of February, 1978;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the said Act shall come into force on Tuesday, the Twenty-first day of February, 1978;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS: Our trusty and well-beloved the Honourable Gordon Arnaud Winter, Officer of Our Order of Canada, Lieutenant-Governor in and for Our Province of Newfoundland.

AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE in Our City of St. John's this 20th day of January in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-eight and in the twenty-sixth year of Our Reign.

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the Honourable Gordon A. Winter, Lieutenant-Governor of the Province of Newfoundland, has been granted leave of absence from the Province from Sunday, 29th. January, 1978, to Saturday, 4th. February, 1978, both dates inclusive;

AND WHEREAS by Letters Patent under the Great Seal of Canada dated the twenty-eighth day of July Anno Domini one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine I was constituted and appointed to be the Administrator of the Government of the Province of Newfoundland and to execute the office and functions of Lieutenant-Governor thereof in the event that the Lieutenant-Governor should be unable to execute this office and the functions of Lieutenant-Governor by reason of absence;

THEREFORE, I Robert Stafford Furlong, Chief Justice of the Province of Newfoundland, have thought fit to publish this my Proclamation in order to make known to all Officers, Civil or Military, and to all persons in the Province of Newfoundland that I, pursuant to the said appointment, have assumed the administration of the Government of the Province of Newfoundland, and all persons are hereby enjoined and commanded to conform themselves thereto.
