GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by Section 15 of *The Small Claims Act*, Chapter 34 of The Statutes of
Newfoundland, 1979, it is provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be
fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act shall come into force on
Monday, the third day of November, 1980;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our
Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the said
Act shall come into force on Monday, the third day of November, 1980;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these
Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accord-
ingly.

and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.
