A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 66.5(4) of *The Insurance Companies Act*, it is provided that  
section 66.5 of the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our  
Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said section 66.5 of the said Act shall come  
into force on Saturday, the first day of January, 1983;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province  
of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that section 66.5 of the said  
Act shall come into force on Saturday, the first day of January, 1983;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may  
concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
