GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 15 of *The Act to Amend The Public Service (Collective Bargaining) Act, 1973*, Chapter 24 of The Statutes of Newfoundland, 1983, it is provided that the said Act or any part thereof shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act, with the exception of sections 2, 6 and 8, shall come into force on Friday, the tenth day of June, 1983;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the said Act, with the exception of sections 2, 6 and 8, shall come into force on Friday, the tenth day of June, 1983;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly;

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS: Our trusty and well-beloved the Honourable Arthur S. Mifflin, Chief Justice, Administrator, in and for Our Province of Newfoundland.
