GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 9 of *An Act to Amend The Workers' Compensation Act, 1983*, Chapter 38 of the Statutes of Newfoundland, 1986, it is provided that this Act or any provision thereof shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that sections 1, 2, 3, 4.(1), 6, 7 and 8 of the said Act shall come into force on Monday, the 16 day of February, 1987;

NOW KNOW YE that we, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that sections 1, 2, 3, 4.(1), 6, 7 and 8 of the said Act shall come into force on Monday, the 16th day of February, 1987;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
