GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by Section 32 of *The Provincial Institutes Act*, Chapter 16 of the Statutes
of Newfoundland, 1987, it is provided that this Act or any provision thereof shall come into force
on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Act shall come into force on Monday,
the 3rd day of August, 1987;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province
of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that *The Provincial Institutes
Act* shall come into force on Monday, the 3rd day of August, 1987;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may
concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.
