TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME,

GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 39 of *The Provincial Court Act, 1991* (the "Act") it is provided that the said Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed it expedient that the said Act shall come into force on Wednesday the 16th day of October, 1991;

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that *The Provincial Court Act, 1991*, Chapter 15 of the Statutes of Newfoundland, 1991, shall come into force on Wednesday the 16th day of October, 1991;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECT AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
