WHEREAS in and by section 341 of *An Act Respecting Elections, Controverted Elections and Election Financing*, s.N. 1992 Ch. E-31. ("The Act") it is provided that, *inter alia*, the Act or a section or part thereof, shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed expedient that Part IV of the Act shall now come into force;

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that Part IV of *An Act Respecting Elections, Controverted Elections and Election Financing*, Chapter E-3.1 of the Statutes of Newfoundland, 1992, shall come into force on the date of publication of this Our Proclamation in Our Newfoundland Gazette;

ALL OF WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS who these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF WE have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland to be hereunto affixed.
