GREETING;

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 58 of the *Social Workers Association Act*, being Chapter 5-18.1 of the 1992 Statutes of Newfoundland (the "Act") it is provided that the Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed it expedient that the Act shall come into force on Wednesday the 1st day of September, 1993;

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that the *Social Workers Association Act*, being Chapter 5-18.1 of the 1992 Statutes of Newfoundland, shall come into force on Wednesday the 1st day of September, 1993;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
