GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 27 of *The Chiropractors Act*, it is provided that the said Act shall come
into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed it expedient that the Act shall come into force on Wednesday the 1st day of July, 1992;

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that *The Chiropractors Act*, Chapter C-14 of the Revised Statutes of Newfoundland, 1990, shall come into force on Wednesday the 1st day of July, 1992;

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

The Child Seating and Restraint System Regulations, 1992
under the
Highway Traffic Act
(O.C. 461-92)

REGULATIONS

1. These Regulations may be cited as The Child Seating and Restraint System Regulations, 1992.
2. In these Regulations, "Act" means the *Highway Traffic Act*.
3. For the purpose of section 178 of the Act, a child seating and restraint system is one that complies with the requirements of the Motor Vehicle Safety Regulations under the *Motor Vehicle Safety Act* (Canada) and has been properly installed in a motor vehicle.
