The House met at 1:30 o'clock in the afternoon pursuant to adjournment.

The Member for St. John's Centre (Ms. Rogers) made a Statement to inform the House about an open Town Hall on Mental Health which will take place on June 4<sup>th</sup>.

The Member for Lake Melville (Mr. Russell) made a Statement to recognize Libra House and the Mokami Status of Women organizations for their contribution to their community.

The Member for Carbonear – Harbour Grace (Mr. Slade) made a Statement to recognize Dr. Lonzel Button for his 38 years of service to rural Newfoundland and Labrador and wish him good health in his retirement.

The Member for Lewisporte (Mr. Verge) made a Statement to congratulate the graduating classes of Riverwood Academy and Lewisporte Collegiate.

The Member for Humber Valley (Mr. Ball) made a Statement to pay tribute to the late Mrs. Jean Kelly.

The Honourable the Minister of Child, Youth and Family Services (Mr. Jackman) made a Statement to recognize the Newfoundland and Labrador Foster Families Association as they prepare for their annual symposium.

The Honourable the Minister Responsible for the Status of Women (Ms. Shea) made a Statement to announce the launch of Phase II of the Cybersafe Girl Initiative.

The Member for St. John's Centre (Ms. Rogers) presented a Petition from certain residents of the Province calling upon the House of Assembly to urge Government to reinstate the Family Violence Intervention Court.

The Member for St. John's East (Mr. Murphy) presented a Petition from certain residents of the Province calling upon the House of Assembly to urge Government to establish a procedure to enable insurance companies to co-ordinate with police, highway enforcement officers and the Motor Registration Division to remove unlicensed and uninsured vehicles from our province's highways.

The Member for The Straits – White Bay North (Mr. Mitchelmore) presented a Petition from certain residents of the Province calling upon the House of Assembly to urge Government to provide Trinity Bay South with cellular service.

The Member for St. John's North (Mr. Kirby) presented a Petition from certain residents of the Province calling upon the House of Assembly to urge Government to change the outdated 1.6 km school busing eligibility policy in order to ensure safe travel to school for primary and elementary school children.

The Member for St. John's East (Mr. Murphy) presented a Petition from certain residents of the Province calling upon the House of Assembly to urge Government to install weather cameras on the Burin Peninsula Highway.

The Honourable the Government House Leader (Mr. King) moved, pursuant to Standing Order 32 that the Orders of the Day be read.

Pursuant to order and on motion debate continued on the motion "That This House Approves in General the Budgetary Policy of the Government" (the Budget Speech) and on motion debate was adjourned for further debate on tomorrow.
