The Member for Exploits (Mr. Forsey) made a Statement to congratulate the Botwood Collegiate Warriors Girls' Softball team for winning the 4A Regional Softball Championships.

The Member for Signal Hill – Quidi Vidi (Ms. Michael) made a Statement to congratulate the City of St. John's, the Bannerman Park Foundation and the volunteers and donors who have contributed to the revitalizing of Bannerman Park.

The Honourable the Minister of Health and Community Services (Mr. Kent) made a Statement to provide an update on the province's Cancer Control Policy Framework.

The Member for Signal Hill – Quidi Vidi (Ms. Michael) presented a Petition from certain residents of the Province calling upon the House of Assembly to urge Government to implement the recommendations of the 2012 Minimum Wage Review Committee and legislate an immediate increase in the minimum wage to reflect the loss of purchasing power since 2010, and an annual adjustment beginning in 2015 to reflect the Consumer Price Index.

The Member for Cartwright – L'Anse au Clair (Ms. Dempster) presented a Petition from certain residents of the Province calling upon the House of Assembly to urge Government to work with the appropriate agencies to provide adequate broadband service to communities along the Labrador Coast.

The Member for Humber East (Mr. Flynn) presented a Petition from certain residents of the Province calling upon the House of Assembly to urge Government to ask the Department of Education to provide free text books to all pupils who attend any school that follows the requirements of the *Schools Act, 1997*.

The Member for St. George's – Stephenville East (Mr. Reid) presented a Petition from certain residents of the Province calling upon the House of Assembly to urge Government to take action to attract a permanent doctor or make other arrangements to improve health care service in St. George's and surrounding area.

The Member for Carbonear – Harbour Grace (Mr. Slade) presented a Petition from certain residents of the Province calling upon the House of Assembly to urge Government to increase moose vehicle accident mitigation measures, including moose fencing, brush cutting and increasing quotas, and to provide financial assistance to those most seriously injured as a result of said collisions.
